The Kintock Group is a non-profit organization that provides cost-effective alternatives to incarceration and reentry services in Pennsylvania and New Jersey for individuals transitioning from the criminal justice system to the community. Kintock's residential and nonresidential services include:

Residential Programs

In Newark and Bridgeton, New Jersey, Kintock provides residential services to adult male and female ex-offenders through contracts with the New Jersey Department of Corrections (NJDOC), the New Jersey State Parole Board and the Federal Bureau of Prisons (BOP). In Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, Kintock contracts with the Federal BOP and the Pennsylvania Department of Corrections to provide residential reentry center services designed to reduce recidivism.

Day Reporting Programs

In Newark and Paterson, New Jersey, Kintock provides Community Resource Center (CRC) Services to male and female offenders under the supervision of the New Jersey State Parole Board. CRC programs also provide "step down" services for formerly incarcerated male and female clients transitioning from residential community programs. CRC's are operational six days per week to provide clients with the appropriate level of services to aid with their successful community adjustment.

Post-Release Programs

Vantage Point

In addition to its residential and nonresidential services, Kintock provides free reentry services to individuals returning from prison through its Vantage Point programs in New Jersey and Pennsylvania. These programs are operated in partnership with the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs, NJ LEAD and the Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency (PCCD).

Village of Hope

Kintock's Village of Hope Transitional Housing Program provides temporary, stable and safe housing to support the reentry needs of eligible individuals in Bridgeton, New Jersey.

Reentry Services for Individuals in New Jersey and Pennsylvania
